
Q SPEAKS...






A speaks.

Q: "Obey, yes. But why would anyone expect you to love someone you fear?"




A speaks.


Q: "The supposed power of love..."




A speaks.




Q: "So Satan fell because he would neither fear God nor love him?"


***A: "No. Satan fell

A: "Nothing is outside God. There is nothing other than God. Not Satan, however. Satan is not God and he'll never be as big as God no matter how much he wants to be."




Q: "Satan wanted to be his abuser, his master, his tyrant? He wanted to be his own abuser, his own master, his own tyrant?"

A speaks.


*A: "Satan wanted to be



Q: "Being free of Fear?"





is being free of God?"





aftermath of Pain."*






A: "Yes. It is the force behind all desires, all emotions, all perceptions, all meaning. The Power of Fear & Pain is at the very heart of Being... being alive."








A: "The ruler who is no longer being ruled is the ruler who is no longer being ruled by Fear."




***A: "The ruler who rules with

but is feared."***




A: "The desire to be the abuser, the master, the tyrant, is the desire to no longer fear being the abused, the slave, the servant, the peasant."

A: "Only that extremely limited personal freedom which is achieved by enslaving others."




A: "And that's hardly anything new. That's hardly any sort of real change, let alone a rebellion or revolution."




Q: "Then who was Satan if not a rebel? If not The Rebel? If not anything truly new or original? If not absolute and unlimited freedom?"

A: "Yes. Who was Satan?"


